
SCHEDULE V. SCHEDULE OF RIVERS

Esplanade Reserves or strips may be required to be set aside where land includes or abuts the following scheduled rivers or streams as Financial Contributions as a condition of a resource consent for subdivision or land use (See Section 16).

Any application to add to this schedule, or remove waterways from it, is able to be considered through the Plan Change provisions of the Resource Management Act. Such applications will be considered where it is reasonable and appropriate for the purposes of riparian management. Applications will be assessed on the following criteria:

- actual or potential scenic, amenity and recreational values including fishery values, indigenous fish and their habitat and the habitat of trout;
- the intensity of land uses, their proximity to watercourses and the actual or potential contamination from diffuse sources;
- existing degraded habitat quality including instream habitat and the extent or loss of existing vegetation;
- existing degraded water quality including high water temperature, suspended solids, nitrate levels and dissolved reactive phosphate levels.

In determining any additions to the Schedule on the basis of what is 'reasonable and appropriate' in any given situation the following matters will be taken into account:

- the physical characteristics of the site and river margins
- the benefits of riparian management for the river or stream
- the riparian management objectives and policies contained in the Plan.
