Ngā paearu **Criteria**

The Pātea Centennial Bursary is available **to eligible applicants for the first four years of their tertiary study**. In applying to the Bursary, applicants **must**:

- Have normally been a resident of the Pātea Ward of the South Taranaki District for the previous two years;
- Be over the age of 15 years;
- Be available for full or part-time study;
- Present themselves for interview when required unless prevented by serious injury or illness;

Applicants who are in course-related or holiday employment located at a considerable distance from Pātea or Waverley may ask to be excused from the interview. Apologies need to be given at least seven days prior to the interviews being held. Successful applicants will be expected to provide a minimum of one progress report through the year.
