Frequently Asked Questions

I'm in Group 3 and was told I need a code to book my appointment – do I still need one?

You don't need a code now and Group 3 will be given priority.

How long will I have to wait until my appointment?

Due to the number of people in Taranaki we need to vaccinate, you can expect your first appointment in six to eight weeks from the time of booking.

Why do I need to book? Can't I just go to a vaccination clinic and get my vaccine?

We need to manage our stocks of the vaccine very carefully to ensure none are wasted. This means we plan to vaccinate those who have booked appointments.

Where are vaccination clinics held?

There is one vaccination centre in New Plymouth and one in Hāwera. Some GP clinics and pharmacies will also offer vaccinations. When you book online, just enter the name of your nearest large town and all the options available to you will appear. If you call the 0800 number, they will talk you through the options.
