The unveiling of the Pou Information Board was held last week in Bridger Park in Eltham. This is a new sign showing the different elements of the Pou and explaining their meaning and importance to Eltham. Work is progressing well on the Clifford Road-Collingwood Street intersection located on the Heavy Vehicle Bypass in Eltham. The excavation for the first of the concrete sections has been completed by the Contractor, and boxing and steel placement has begun. The first concrete pour will start next week. The replacement watermains (that form part of the original project) will be pressure tested this week above ground, before installation in the coming weeks. There have been no traffic or pedestrian issues reported to date, and the single traffic lane operating under traffic lights for both light and heavy vehicles is working well.
