Specific parts of the application that my submission relates to are:	Relocation of St John the Divine church in Otakeho from 4 Campbell Rd, Otakeho to 3500 South Road Pihama.
My Submission is:	We SUPPORT the relocation of St John the Divine Church Otakeho to 3500 South Rd, Pihama. At present the Church building is isolated and vulnerable on its current site. Relocation is the best way to save the building and ensure its long-term viability as well as maintaining its aesthetic, historic and cultural significance to the community. There are many links with significant local families e.g. the Stained Glass Windows, and the Church is part of the architectural body of work by Frederick de Jersey Clere. The structure is potentially compromised if it is left in situ. Expediting the relocation is an effective way to conserve this building, ensuring it remains in Taranaki, and it will continue to hold the story of the past for the future.
