Over recent years I have seen the Church deteriorate to a state that I feel needs attention.

I would feel very sad if it became the eyesore that the disused School across the road has become.

One of the worrying aspects is the safety of the chattels that families have donated to the Church, if the Church was to stay where it is.

Having the Church relocated to the Stevenson's property would secure the future safety of all these memorial chattels.

I am aware of the resource application being presented by Mark and Trish Stevenson and their intentions of relocating the church to their property in Pihama.

I feel this is the only way forward for the preservation of the old Church.

The Otakeho and Pihama communities have the same values.

Even though the Church would reside in Pihama it would still be referred to as the Otakeho Church.

I also feel it is very important to preserve local history and have somewhere to put items of local interest and the Vestry of the Church is an ideal place to have it displayed.
