

## Come along and enjoy taking part in South Taranaki's premier outdoor arts and crafts festival

Enjoy the large, pleasant, open environment of King Edward Park to exhibit, demonstrate and sell your arts or crafts, or perhaps you would like to come and busk? Arts in the Park provides space for quality work in a peaceful setting where there is no pressure on visitors to buy or take part if they do not wish. Use the entire park and take advantage of the colourful spaces to provide interest for the visiting public. A walk through the park is a *voyage of discovery* for all those who take part or visit.

The day is for artists and crafts people to display and sell their hand made arts and crafts, for example, knitting, weaving, carving, painting, iron sculpture, hand made jewellery, wood work etc, rather than for second hand or mass produced goods. Above all, Arts in the Park is a pleasant and friendly experience for the exhibitors and visitors alike.

Are you a performance artist? Do you sing? Play a musical instrument? Dramatics? Part of a performing group? If you would like to perform on the day, mark the registration form accordingly and you will be allocated a time and area in the park to perform.

Arts in the Park will be on Saturday 2 December 2017 from 10.00 am to 3.00 pm. Please note that there will be no postponement day – if on Saturday the weather is not appropriate we will take the event indoors to TSB Hub. If you would like to know if the event has been moved indoors or have questions, contact 027 426 4555 or 0800 111 323.

There are a few housekeeping rules so that everybody is accommodated and there is a pleasant ambience.

### Conditions of Exhibitors:

- ⇒ Each person is responsible for setting up their site far enough away from their neighbour so as not to impose on them. All props and materials needed to operate are to be supplied by the exhibitor.
- ⇒ There is no formal booking of a particular space. Most individual sites are on a *first come-first served* basis. Please indicate the approximate size of your site on the booking form. Certain areas will be set up and reserved for specific activities, for example. children's art area, food, stage etc. There will also be an area taped off for foot traffic (or look for the mown walk ways).
- ⇒ Stallholders will be asked to not park along High Street by the park as we would like to reserve this area for visitor cars. You will be told of other parking options closer to the time,
- ⇒ Sites should be completely set up and ready to operate by 10.00 am and maintain operation until 3.00 pm, to comply with advertising material.
- ⇒ **No vehicles are allowed into King Edward Park.** There will be assistance available at the Stan Lay entrance (off Camberwell Road) and also on High Street (look for the coned off area) to help you bring you items into the Park. **If you bring your own trailer this will be towed into and out of the park for you.**
- ⇒ Please no pressure sales talks to visitors.
- ⇒ The Council is not responsible for any loss or damages.
- ⇒ There will be no offensive material in the Park. The intention is not to offend visitors and a concept of art in all forms will be borne in mind. Artists are expected to comply with Council staff if visitors to the park think any material is offensive.
- ⇒ The Council will be responsible for all advertising and promotion at the Council's cost.
- ⇒ There is no charge to the exhibitor to take part in the event.
- ⇒ If the event is moved indoors, there will limited space so you may be required to downsize your display area.
