## RATES REBATE SCHEME ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

The Rates Rebate Scheme was established in 1973 by the Government to provide a subsidy to low-income homeowners on the cost of their rates.



You can apply for a rates rebate if:

- Your annual income is less than \$22,340.00. There is an additional income allowance of \$500 per dependant)
- You have to pay rates on the address you live at, and
- You were living there at the beginning of the rating year (1 July), and
- Your name is on the rates bill, or
- You are the owner of an "Owner-occupier flat" and your name is not on the bill but you pay some of the rates (proof is required).

The maximum rebate given for 2010/2011 is \$570.00
