From September 2020, we will only accept plastics marked 1, 2 and 5 in your yellow-lidded recycling bin for Council kerbside collection and at the transfer stations.

Keep an eye out for announcements through our Antenno App, STDC Rubbish and Recycling App, Council Facebook page and Southlink to stay up-to-date on recycling in Taranaki. If you want to know more, visit the 'Rubbish and Recycling' section of our website www.southtaranaki.com All other plastics marked 3, 4, 6 and 7 now need to go in your red-lidded landfill wheelie bin, as these will not be recycled.

Top tips for sorting your hangarua (recycling)



1. EMPTY & RINSE

Remove all liquids and food scraps.



2. REMOVE LIDS Place lids in the red landfill bin.



3. DON'T SQUASH Leave bottles and containers unsquashed.
