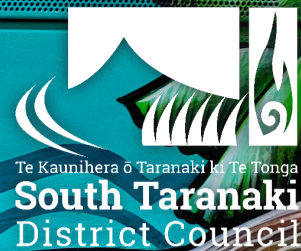

## District-wide odds and evens Water Restrictions now in place

This is a friendly reminder that District-wide water restrictions are currently in place. The restrictions mean all unattended hoses, sprinklers and irrigation systems are banned. Hand-held hoses may be used early in the morning or in the evening on the odds and evens system (at even-numbered houses on even calendar dates, and odd numbered houses on odd dates).
