Annual Dog Registration Due



If your dog is over the age of three months, it needs to be registered and microchipped - simply pop into the Hāwera Administration Building or your local LibraryPlus to get this done.

If you are re-registering a dog, look out for your renewal form in your letterbox over the next couple of weeks.

Take advantage of early bird rates by paying in full by 31 July 2022. After this date, registration fees increase by 50%.

Notifications from Council

Antenno lets you choose the places you want to be alerted about, so you're only being alerted about things that matter to you. You can pick multiple "Places" (which could be the area you live in, work, where your children go to school, or where you like to exercise your dog) and then you will see updates from council on community events, matters up for consultation, water shutdowns, changes to rubbish collections and much more.

Reporting back to Council

You can also use Antenno to tell us about things that need fixing, or give us feedback, direct through the app! Antenno makes it easy for people to submit feedback or report issues such as a full public rubbish bin, damaged footpath, road pothole, graffiti or submit feedback or an idea to Council. It will be sent directly to us and is then logged in our system as a Customer Request.
