I can't believe I'm writing another Christmas message as it seems like only yesterday that I was penning the last one! Perhaps it's the ageing process, but 2022 has felt a bit like riding a bullet train with everything flashing past in a blur. It certainly

has been a busy year for our District.

Despite the many challenges we continued to face (COVID-19, inflation, and extreme weather events - to name a few), our communities have remained very resilient (please spare a thought for residents cut off in the Mangamingi area). We saw a lot of exciting development throughout the District – both by council and private enterprises. The final stage of Nukumaru Station Road is well underway and very visible from SH3 with the new road to be completed this summer. Construction of Te Ramanui o Ruapūtahanga is well underway and the South Taranaki Business Park is growing very quickly. Our agricultural and food processing sectors have continued to grow as has the construction industry with record numbers of subdivisions and new houses being built. We are seeing a lot of interest in green energy with three players interested in establishing offshore wind farms as well interest in further onshore wind farms.

Council also continued to voice our opposition to the Government's ill-conceived

three waters reform proposal. While they seem determined to ignore better alternative solutions, we will continue to advocate for a better version of reform that respects the decades of investment by local communities and enables them to preserve a real say in how their money is spent in future.

Thank you to the many clubs, organisations, schools and individuals across the district, who have welcomed me, and my wife Tanya, to your meetings, events and special occasions. The opportunity to get out and meet you all is one of the great privileges I get in my role.

Also thanks to those of you who voted in the recent local body elections. We welcomed our newly elected members at Kanihi Māwhitiwhiti Marae in October, including our two new Māori ward councillors. Unfortunately, we need to run a by-election for a Te Hāwera Ward councillor and a Pātea Community Board member – voting will be in January 2023.

Christmas is a great time for catching up with family and friends. However, please continue to do all those things you've been doing to keep yourself and your family safe and well up to this point. If you're driving over the holiday season, take care on the roads, stay calm, and take plenty of breaks. Have a great Christmas and a happy and healthy new year.
