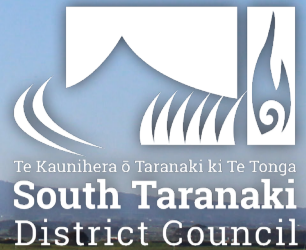

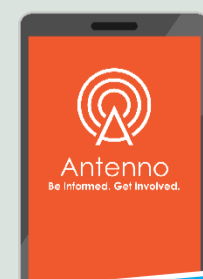
### Notice of impounded stock
