This year's Tangata Whenua Liaison Fund opens for applications from groups, marae, hapū or iwi committees in the District on 31 January. This fund is for those seeking assistance for projects or initiatives that develop positive relationships between Tangata Whenua, Council and the people of South Taranaki. Projects that have received funding include marae water supplies, fire compliance and sanitation facilities, building upgrade projects and the fencing and maintenance of marae and urupā. Te Kāhui Matauraura Committee has also funded community events such as Paepae in the Park. If your committee has a project that matches the criteria, consider making an application to Te Kāhui Matauraura Committee.
